UPDATES – v1 3/12/2025

New to this Update: This release includes a new 2025 cover and a directory page for SHAYLA ELIZABETH, which was mistakenly left out of the prior directory by your webmaster.

What are they:

Updates are provided throughout the calendar year when a new boat is added to the directory or existing boats have updated their information. Each update has a version number and a date so you will know if its newer than the last one you downloaded.

How do they work:

Each update will include the newest cover; all additions/revisions from the prior updates (within current calendar year); any new additions/revisions for the current update version. Download and print the update and add them to your directory.

FAQs:

Q: How will I know that a replacement boat page is the most current?

A: At the bottom of each page there is a footer with the Revised date. e.g. Revised: 2022. The page in the update would normally have a revised date that has a more current date.

Q: I did the prior update and now in this version I see some of the same updates that I already added to my directory. Should I be replacing them all again?

A: NO, you do not need to replace them all again. The updates are cumulative and therefore contain all of the prior updates PLUS the newest updates. They are all included for people that missed the last update.

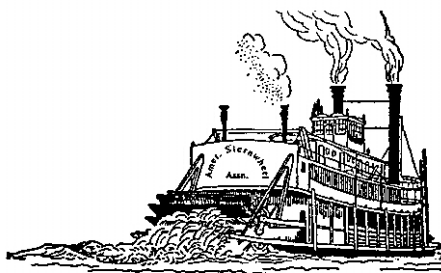
Q: What if I'm just not sure my directory is current?

A: You can always just download a complete directory and dispose of your old one.

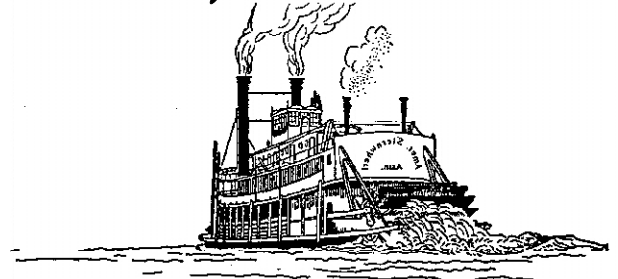
